### **MainStream Global Solutions Will Now Be Considered a Small Business by the SBA Under NAICS 541611**

*Great News for Government Customers and Business Partners: SBA Increases the Management, Scientific and Technical Consulting Services NAICS from \$7 Million to \$14 Million*

**Bethesda, MD (March 8, 2012)** – MainStream Global Solutions, LLC (“MainStream”), a veteran-owned management-consulting firm, will now be considered a small business by the Small Business Administration (SBA) under NAICS 541611: Management, Scientific and Technical Consulting Services. This NAICS received an increase from \$7 million to \$14 million.

“Increasing the SBA-issued size standard is great news for our government customers as they will receive small business credit for contracting with MainStream. Additionally, large SI’s looking to meet their small business sub-contracting goals will benefit as well. MainStream is unique in that even though we are a small business, we provide government and SI’s with proven enterprise past performance that exceeds the past performance of many large businesses in the disciplines we work in,” said MainStream President Alan J. Horowitz.

The SBA will be increasing the size standard for technology companies as well as for 33 other industries under a final rule published February 10<sup>th</sup> in the Federal Register. The move means about 8,350 additional companies will now be eligible to compete for federal contracts as a small business. The final rule will increase 37 of the revenue-based size standards in 34 industries and three sub-industries in the "Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services" sector. It will also increase one size standard in the "Other Services" sector.

Size standards are used to determine eligibility for federal small-business assistance programs. SBA measures "size" for most industries by receipts and number of employees. It defines receipts as the total income plus cost of goods sold. The higher revenue limits cover the professional, technical, and scientific sectors and will take effect on March 12.
